Adeyemi also used the occasion to reiterate and dispel the rumours going around in some quarters that he sold one of the OSGOF properties for N8billion Naira , he said "when they said we sold the house in Lagos we are about to commission for N8b, they came, they didn't come to me directly, they came as a friendly gist , they said, do you have eight billion naira ? I told them, if I have eight billion naira, I will put in my letter of resignation and go to America. Eight billion Naira is not a small amount of money. "

At the event, Special Assistant to SGOF Surv. Danladi Abubakar Ebune, said "Thank you for recognizing what Surveyor General is doing in Nigeria through his office, it is difficult for you to blow your own trumpet. We are proud of your award, the office improvement with staff is number one in Surveyor Generals Agenda"
